## Steps for getting started at SFCC –

1. Please complete and return this Application for Admission to SFCC. Every applicant (including former students who have not been a student at SFCC in the last five years) must completely fill out the application and submit it to the Student Services Office at the Sedalia campus or one of the other convenient locations.
2. Submit an official high school transcript or GED certificate. A final high school transcript with date of graduation must be provided as soon as it is available.
3. Have an official transcript from any college previously attended (including dual credit classes) sent to the Student Services Office at the Sedalia campus.
4. Placement test scores are required prior to registration for:
  - a) all first-time degree-seeking students; and
  - b) all transfer or returning degree-seeking students who have not completed a three credit hour course in college-level English and math with a “C” grade or better, or who have not completed the appropriate prerequisite. ACT, ASSET, COMPASS, or SAT will meet this requirement if taken within the last five years. Just ask for information on how and when to take the test.
5. Submit the \$25.00 one-time, non-refundable application fee. Make check payable to SFCC.

**NOTE:** Contact the Financial Aid Office at the Sedalia campus for information on how to apply for financial aid and their deadlines.

# SFCC Degree Information

State Fair Community College offers Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degrees and Professional Certificates. The AA degree consists of general education courses and electives to prepare you to transfer to a four-year college. The AAS degrees and Professional Certificates consist of career and technical courses and general education courses to prepare students for employment. The AA degree can be completed at the Sedalia campus or at Whiteman Air Force Base. While all AAS degrees and certificates can be completed at the Sedalia campus, limited degrees/certificates have been approved by the Missouri Coordinating Board for Higher Education at other locations.

As you will see below, just because you choose a location to attend as most convenient, you are not limited to take courses only at that site. Many students who take courses off the main campus mix and match locations for their convenience.
