INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

Appropriate Use

State Fair Community College (SFCC) shall provide technological resources to the campus community of students, faculty, staff, and the public to support its educational mission. SFCC technology can provide access to resources on and off campus, as well as the ability to communicate with other users worldwide. This access is a privilege and requires that individual users act responsibly. Users shall respect the rights of other users, the integrity of the systems and related physical resources, and observe all relevant laws, regulations, and contractual obligations. SFCC technological resources shall always be used in compliance with all international, federal, state and local laws.

Use of SFCC technological resources, including but not limited to servers, computers, mobile devices, network services, telephone systems, and cloud-hosted systems is a privilege provided by the college to students and employees for educational, academic, and administrative purposes. The college expects all technology users to understand and abide by these user obligations when using SFCC technological resources.
